

School Fees and Expenses - 2025/2026

This document outlines school fees and expenses for the 2025/2026 school year. All fees are quoted in Japanese Yen and include applicable taxes. The school reviews fees periodically and reserves the right to modify them.

Prospective students who wish to apply to UWC ISAK Japan but are concerned about the cost can visit our website for detailed information about the financial assistance program.

Initial Fees

One-time, non-refundable fees per student.

Application Fee To be paid prior to submitting a complete application.	20,000 JPY
Enrollment Fee To be paid at the point of acceptance to secure your place at UWC ISAK Japan.	300,000 JPY

School Fees

Annual fees per student, per year. All fees are invoiced in June prior to each school year and must be paid in full in July or paid in two equal installments (July and December). The total amount due will remain the same, regardless of whether tuition is paid in one installment or two installments.

School fees cover all costs for tuition, dormitory housing during the school year, daily meal service, textbooks, compulsory medical health checks, insurance, Project Weeks, and expenses for most school activities and trips.

IB Years Fee

*Annual fees per student, per year in **Grades 11 and 12 only**. The IB Years Fee is invoiced and can be paid at the same time as school fees.*

The IB Years Fee is prorated in line with the financial assistance (FA) award for students receiving FA. For example, students receiving a 70% FA award will receive a 70% discount for their IB Years Fee each year.

Estimated Additional Expenses

Apart from the aforementioned fees, families are expected to cover additional expenses as detailed below.

<p>Security Deposit Students will pay a refundable deposit to cover lost or damaged school property or other unanticipated expenses. The unused amount will be applied to the following school year. The remaining balance will be returned to each student at the time of graduation.</p>	40,000 JPY
<p>Laptop Students are required to have a laptop computer to support their learning. Students can either use a laptop they already own or buy a new computer; Apple MacBooks are strongly encouraged, but not mandatory. Detailed information will be provided to accepted students.</p>	Variable
<p>Airport Transportation UWC ISAK Japan provides free transportation from Narita Airport to campus for newly-arriving students who arrive on our designated arrival day. Students are responsible for subsequent transportation to/from the airport.</p>	Variable
<p>Holiday Travel Expenses Unless there are extenuating circumstances, students are expected to return home during the summer break at their own expense.</p>	Variable
<p>University-Related Expenses Students should expect to pay all costs associated with their university application process.</p>	Variable
<p>Pocket Money Spending money to cover the cost of snacks, stationery and local transportation.</p>	Approximately 5,000 JPY per month

Students who are attending UWC ISAK Japan on a full scholarship may be eligible for financial assistance to support them with these additional expenses. The amount of financial assistance provided will be outlined at the point of enrollment.
